Your bail of \$1,000 (for those over 18) and \$500 (for those under 18) has been set to help raise funds to assist in the rescue of Heart of Sailing's boat from Bayland Marina, TX. As you know, Hurricane Ike devastated the Houston-Galveston area, leaving thousands of people homeless and resulting in catastrophic property damage. Bayland Marina was the original site of Heart of Sailing's regional program on the coast in Texas. Heart of Sailing sailboat, the Zephyr, was thrown aground along the highway with dozens of other boats in the marina. However, we're lucky that the boat is salvageable, and with your help, can continue its mission to help deserving children with special needs experience the therapeutic benefits of sailing.
